Doug has broad experience resolving U.S. and international security issues with Latin American and Asian Pacific leaders. He led the DOD disaster relief effort for the 2010 Haiti earthquake coordinating with U.S. federal agencies, Congress, international militaries, international relief organizations, and the United Nations to integrate the U.S. and international response.

He routinely worked with Latin American leaders (Presidents, Ministers, and military Chiefs of Defense) to improve strategic partnerships and implement cooperative action plans while directing U.S. military activities across Latin America. Doug also developed U.S. national security programs with U.S. federal agencies, Congressional committees, foreign governments, and international organizations.
